1. The objectives of the Competition.

The objective of the EA Contest is to select and award construction undertakings completed until the end of first quarter of 2019, standing out with their special values. The idea of the EA Contest is propagating and supporting activities for the purpose of saving facilities and buildings of heritage as well as promoting modernization, alteration and expansion of facilities and devices, as well as construction of new facilities in urban space to obtain functional and aesthetic effects. The EA Contest promotes: functionality of the modernized and rebuilt buildings and constructions, modernity of technologies and design solutions, use of new techniques, modern effective and safe tools, high quality workmanship on construction and conservation works, use of new high-quality materials, high ecological effects, and in case of historic facilities it is about taking care of architecture and protecting the cultural heritage, preserving original values of a building and protecting modern cultural facilities.

2. The subject matter and scope of the EA Contest.

One understands “Modernization” as implementation of a replacement and modernization project that ends up with a lasting functional and conservation effect. The facilities whose modernization or construction was completed until the end of first quarter of 2019 may be entered for the EA Contest.

In the EA Contest the following basic categories of facilities are awarded:

- New facilities in urban space
- Roads
- Elevations and thermal improvement
- Hotel and tourism
- Culture, sport, health and recreation
- Residential
- Bridges
- Environmental protection
- Urban complexes and areas
- Industrial and engineering

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- Sacred
- Education
- Green areas
- Public utility
- Interior
- Historic

Every participant in the modernization process - an Investor, a Contractor and a Designer, has the right to participate in the EA Contest. Each of them may entry a facility independently or it may be entered collectively. Moreover, institutions, associations, developers as well as building and installation materials manufacturers may entry a facility to the EA Contest.

3. Organization of the Competition.

3.1 The EA Contest is held by the Organizing Committee appointed by the organizers. The registered office of the Organizing Committee is: Head Office of the EA Contest, ul. Hetmańska 38, 85-039 Bydgoszcz, Poland, tel. + 48 052 323-07-17, fax. + 48 052 322-67-70

3.2 The Organizing Committee appoints the EA Contest Jury and together with the Award Committee approves regulations of its work, disposes of the financial resources for the organization of the EA Contest, works of the Jury as well as the actions popularizing the EA Contest and its award winners. The Organizing Committee creates a magazine popularizing the EA Contest and appoints its editor-in-chief.

3.3 Apart from representatives of the organizers of the EA Contest, the Jury includes persons appointed by the Organizing Committee and the Jury of the Award Committee. The Organizing Committee has the right, in justified cases, to appoint experts.

3.4 The Jury visits all the facilities qualified to the EA Contest Final, indicates awards and justifies distinctions in writing. Decisions of the Jury are taken by the majority and in the event of a tied vote, the Chairman shall have the casting vote.

4. The Award Committee

The Award Committee, its executive committee and chairman are elected within award winners of the EA Contest by themselves as well as the organizers of the EA Contest. The Award Committee's tasks include:

- 4.1 Cooperation with the Organizing Committee in promotion and organizing the EA Contest
- 4.2 Support in organizing works of the Jury of the EA Contest
- 4.3 Dissemination the idea of the EA Contest in own territory
- 4.4 Representing the organizers of the EA Contest before local authorities
- 4.5 Funding and awarding own special award
- 4.6 Cooperation with local authorities

5. The criteria for the assessment.

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5.1 The level of architectural and urban solutions

5.2 The functionality of modernized and converted facilities and buildings

5.3 The level of keeping the architecture of buildings, structures and other historic elements

5.4 Modernity of the used technology

5.5 Application of a new technique in implementation and technological processes.

5.8 The ecological effects obtained (concerns the environmental protection facilities)

6. The course of action for the assessment.

6.1 Two-stage proceedings

Stage I - the proceedings consist in formal examination of documents sent by an entity entering a facility for the EA Contest.

The participant are notified in writing about the decision within 60 days from the entry.

Stage II - an initial assessment of an facility on the basis of an analysis of obtained documents as well as an on-site visit. The Jury of the EA Contest will inform the participants about results of this stage.

6.2 Separate record of documents is kept for each facility entered for the EA Contest.

6.3 The Organizing Committee in agreement with the companies whose facilities participate in the EA Contest, organizes events presenting the participants of the EA Contest as well as promotes its award winners through:

- An exhibition illustrating the participants of the EA Contest, e.g. display-boards, models, films etc.
- Information and press conferences,
- Special press publications,
- Special publications about the results of the EA Contest – Final Catalogue
- Promoting materials concerning the award winners during various current scientific, technical and trade events,
- Presentation of the participants of the EA Contest at the construction trades.
- Presentation on websites

7. The rules for the participation.

The entry of an facility is made as indicated in Appendix No. 1 and 2 to the regulations hereof.

The entry for the EA Contest results in making the facility and documentation available to the visiting Jury. The entity entering a facility constructed in the territory of Poland, shall pay the following amounts for the organizational costs of the EA Contest:

EUR 795 for the construction with outlays up to EUR 62 500,

EUR 1195 for the construction with outlays up to EUR 125 500,

EUR 1395 for the construction with outlays up to EUR 230 000,

EUR 1795 for the construction with outlays up to EUR 625 000,

EUR 2195 for the construction with outlays up to EUR 1 250 000,

EUR 2495 for the construction with outlays above EUR 1 250 000,

Discounts:

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- 1 facility – 0% discount
- 2 facilities – 15% discount
- 3 facilities – 25 % discount
- 4 facilities – 50% discount

8. The entry for the EA Contest shall include:

- A declaration of entering for the EA Contest (The model set out in the Annex No. 1),
- Basic data characterizing the modernization (The model set out in the Annex No. 2),
- The technical description and photos of a facility taken before and after the modernization.
- The organizer reserves the right to use any materials delivered by a submitting party for the promotional and marketing purposes related to the EA Contest.

9. The Award Winners.

In the one anticipates two stages of awarding and a special award I The stage means awarding the title of EA Contest.

The title is awarded in each category for: an investor, a construction/building company and a project author/architect/designer.

The award winners will be given the „European Award 2019” statuette, a certificate of merit as well as promotion in the press free of charge.

II Stage means awarding the „European Award 2019” certificate of merit in each category for all 3 participants of the modernization process as well as promotion in the press free of charge.

Special Award: means awarding award or distinction by individual organizers of the EA Contest, sponsors, patrons, media patrons, public institutions and the Ward Committee. It is also given by the Jury of the EA Contest in agreement with sponsors and the patron. The awards are of honour and material or financial nature. They are given along with the main awards during the ceremonial adjudication of the EA Contest.

The Award Winner is entitled to place an information board on the awarded facility with the following inscription: The “European Award 2019” title as well as it has the right to use the logo of the EA Contest in its promotional and marketing materials.

In duly justified specific cases the Jury may award a special award in the EA Contest for modernization achievements going beyond one edition of the EA Contest. The Jury while making an assessment of the submitted facilities, may not award the “European Award 2019” title in individual categories.

10. General Provisions.

Decisions of the Jury of the EA Contest are final and binding and are not subject to appeal or complaint.

The Award Committee of the EA Contest supervises the correct course of the Competition. Rules for carrying out the EA Contest and its name are legally protected.

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
